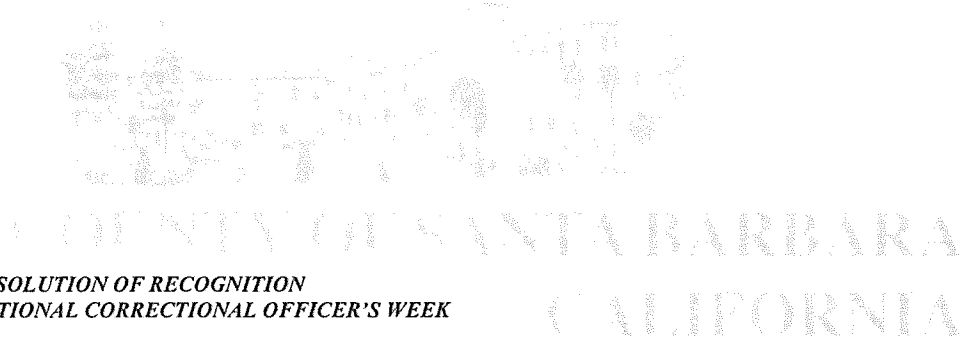

**RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION




