RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MARCH 24, 2009 WORLD TUBERCULOSIS DAY IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, each year nearly 2 million people die and 9 million people become sick with TB world-wide and because TB infects one-third of the world's population; and

WHEREAS in 2008, more than 2600 active TB cases were reported in California; with 34 of those active cases occurring in Santa Barbara County; and

WHEREAS in 2008, the Disease Control staff evaluated 260 persons who had close contact with these 34 active cases to prevent further spread of TB; and

WHEREAS, Disease Control staff and PHD partners successfully responded to a surge in TB cases among homeless individuals in November 2008 ensuring those with active TB were treated and those who had close contact were screened and cleared; and

WHEREAS, given global travel and immigration patterns and the airborne spread of TB, public health departments must continue to be prepared for the control of TB; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County Public Health Tuberculosis Control Program continues to work to develop and implement strategies for prevention, surveillance, control and treatment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim, March 24, 2009, as World Tuberculosis Day in Santa Barbara County.
