Recommended Action(s):

Authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to:

- A. Approve the attached <u>Notice of Exemption</u> pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines re: vacating a portion of the County's right-of-way known as Main Street in Los Alamos, adjacent to Santa Barbara County Assessor's Parcel No. 101-260-056 as shown on the Exhibit attached to said Notice; and
- B. Adopt the attached Resolution, <u>Summary Order to Vacate</u>, vacating the above referenced portion of Main Street.

Summary:

The area proposed for vacation is unused right-of-way underlying A.P.N. 101-260-056 as shown on Exhibit "A" attached to the Summary Order to Vacate (herein the "Portion"). Public Works Transportation, Flood Control and Real Property representatives have viewed the Portion and have no objection to the proposed vacation. There are no County road facilities within the Portion and the County has no plans to expand its infrastructure in the vicinity of the Portion. There is a drainage swale in the Portion, and the County's right to maintain that swale will be reserved. The rights of the Public utility providers currently operating within the Portion will be reserved. No Parcels will be "landlocked" if the vacation is consummated.

If consummated the road vacation will dispose of approximately 1,501 square feet (20' X 75') of unimproved and unused County road right-of-way by removing the public right to use the Portion. If the vacation is consummated the remaining right-of-way will be 80 feet wide on Main Street; Transportation requires a 60 foot wide right-of-way on Main Street. The vacation will also remove the County's liabilities associated with ownership of an interest in the Portion.

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Background:

The fee owner of the parcel burdened by the Portion contacted Public Works and requested the removal of the public interest in the Portion. No County departments objected to the proposed vacation and it was found to be in conformity with the County's adopted General Plan by the Planning Commission. All public utility providers were informed of the proposed vacation by letter and asked if they maintain facilities in the Portion. The rights of those providers currently operating within the Portion will be reserved from the vacation.
