UNIFIED ORDERING POINT: VENTURA COUNTY

This cost share agreement between the above-named agencies was prepared under the following guidelines:

1. In accordance with the "California Master Cooperative Wildland Fire Management and Stafford Act Response Agreement" between the USDA Forest Service, USDI Bureau of Land Management (BLM), USDI National Park Service, USDI Fish and Wildlife Service, USDI Bureau of Indian Affairs, and CAL FIRE.
2. In accordance with the 2016 Contract County Annual Operating plans between Ventura County and CAL FIRE and Santa Barbara County and CAL FIRE.
3. In accordance with the "California Master Cooperative Wildland Fire Management and Stafford Act Response Agreement" Annual Operating Plan – Central Coast Group 2017 between the Bakersfield Field Office-BLM, Los Padres National Forest, San Luis Obispo Unit, CAL FIRE, Ventura County Fire Department and Santa Barbara County Fire Department.

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4. In accordance with the Cooperative Fire Protection Agreements between the U.S. Forest Service, Los Padres National Forest and each of the following agencies: Santa Barbara County Fire Department, City of Santa Barbara Fire Department, Montecito Fire Protection District and the Carpinteria Summerland Fire Protection District.
5. All costs originating from orders placed by and for the incident that can be reasonably obtained and estimated for the cost share period will be included in this agreement and will be shared on the basis of the incident commanders, agency representative or line officers' mutual agreement.
6. Costs for non-expendable property purchases by each agency will be charged direct to that agency and will not be shared.
7. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged in joint fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
8. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
9. Responsibility for tort claim costs or compensation for injury costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside of this agreement.
10. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
11. Daily cost sharing will be documented and approved by the delegated agency representative for cost apportionment.
12. Shared costs will be based on the incident commanders, agency representatives and line officers mutual judgment and agreement as to threat, incident objectives, and resources assigned for each agency's area of responsibility.
13. Aircraft and retardant costs will be shared on an actual use basis as determined by the incident commanders, agency representatives and line officers and will be calculated as a separate cost.
14. Sharing of final actual costs between the agencies will be based on a summary of daily estimated incident suppression costs and each agency's proportionate share thereof as agreed to by the jurisdictional representatives.


17. The Thomas Fire has been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for Fire Management Assistance Grants (FMAG). In order to meet FMAG due dates, all financial packages will be submitted to Michelle Lawrence, CAL FIRE, by August 4, 2018, for preparation of a draft cost share settlement. The parties to this agreement will meet to finalize the cost share settlement, which will determine the total costs of each agency and the agency(ies) whose total costs exceed their proportional share of the overall incident final costs, as determined within this agreement, will bill the other agency(ies). These billings, when paid, will result in each agency sharing overall incident costs as herein agreed.

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18. An administrative charge, the pre-established percentage set by each agency, will be applied pursuant to agency policy by the agency issuing the settlement billing for the net amount owed.

This agreement and the apportionment are our best judgments of agency cost responsibilities.




