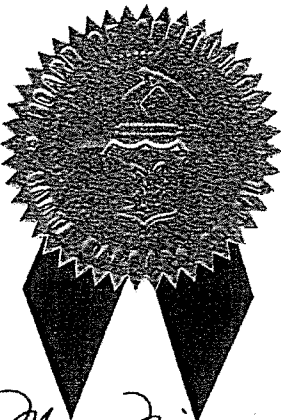
WHEREAS, Allen somehow unlocked the fountain of youth and secrets to good health, having taken a total of only 11 sick days over his entire 20-year career; and
