Approve plans and specifications for the Via Rueda Storm Drain Interceptor Project Phase II.

Summary Text:

This project consists of constructing approximately 225 linear feet of 30 inch diameter storm drain in Puente Drive, in the unincorporated area of eastern Goleta area. The project will connect the downstream terminus of Via Rueda Interceptor Storm Drain Phase I to Atascadero Creek. Phase I was completed in 2007 and was designed to improve the drainage of Vieja Drive, located above Via Rueda, and relieve the Flood Control District's maintenance staff from having to further maintain the remaining portions of the previously existing drainage system through the quitclaiming of easements. Phase II represents the final phase of this project.

On August 20, 2008, the Flood Control District received thirteen bids for the Via Rueda Storm Drain Interceptor Project Phase II. Shaw Excavating and Grading submitted the apparent lowest bid in the amount of \$85,567.50. The contract amount is within the informal bidding process of \$125,000 so the construction contract will be awarded by the Public Works Director.

Background:

Pursuant to the Public Contracting Code, the Public Works Director has the authority to award construction contracts under \$125,000. Since the bid amount including the 10% contingency is within the informal contracting limit of \$125,000, the Public Works Director will execute the construction contract for this project.

Completion of this project will improve drainage and decrease flooding potential to the Via Rueda/Puente Drive neighborhood.

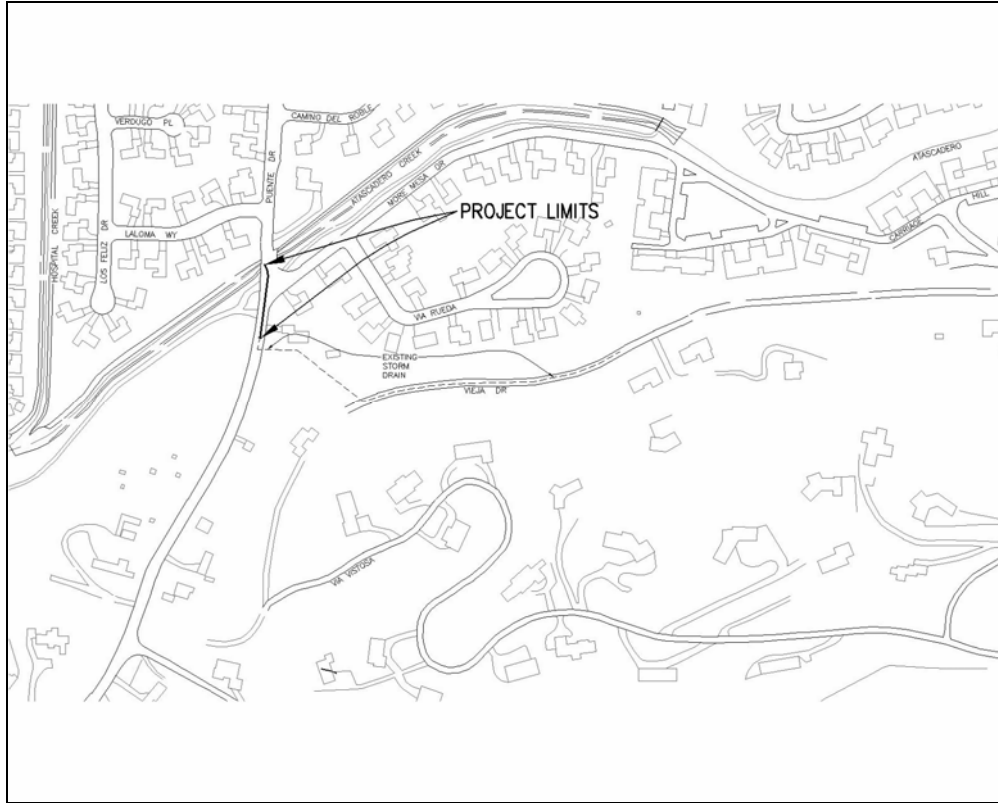
