SUBJECT: Parking Restrictions on State Route 192 (Foothill Road), 1st Supervisorial District

Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Adopt a Resolution for the establishment of (2) No Parking zones on State Route 192 (Foothilll Road) in the Mission Canyon area, 1st Supervisorial District;
- B. Approve Notice of Exemptions pursuant to the County's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines for the above.

Summary Text:

The Public Works Department received several requests from citizens in the Mission Canyon area that had safety concerns related to parking on State Route 192 (Foothill Road) in the County of Santa Barbara. The roadway at this location was recently widened to provide additional shoulder width for a vehicle recovery safety zone, as well as providing additional width for bicycles. Eliminating parking at this location is necessary to designate a safe passage for those traveling along State Route 192. Caltrans has agreed to install the No Parking signs as part of the State Route 192 Widening Project. It is typical, when a No Parking zone is established on a State Route, for the local agency to adopt the Resolution. Caltrans concurs with the Department's recommendation, thus we are requesting your Board's approval of this Resolution.

There may be areas along the north side of State Route 192 where parking is appropriate and does not result in a safety issue. After the construction project is completed, County staff will review the north side of State Route 192 and determine appropriate locations for No Parking. Based upon our investigation, the Department has prepared the attached Resolution establishing parking restrictions at the following locations:

ADOPT

No Parking Zones

- On the south side of State Route 192 (Foothill Road), from the centerline of Mission Canyon Road to the centerline of Tye Road.
- On the north side of State Route 192 (Foothill Road), from the centerline of Mission Canyon Road to the centerline of Tye Road, to be designated at the discretion of the Road Commissioner.

Background:

Parking restrictions are either established or rescinded based on safety, necessity, and the use by the community as a whole. The Department weighs all of these factors and presents any recommended changes to the Board of Supervisors for approval. These parking restrictions may include no parking, time limited parking, loading zones, vehicle height restricted parking, angle parking, handicapped parking or any combination of these restrictions.

State Route 192:

Citizens of the Mission Canyon area initiated the request for no parking zones in the recently widened and restriped area of State Route 192, due to safety concerns.
