SUBJECT: North Jameson Lane Class II Bike Lanes and Bridge Replacement Project, First Supervisorial District - Project No. 863027

Recommendations:

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for construction bids for the North Jameson Lane Class II Bike Lanes and Bridge Replacements Project, First Supervisorial District, County Project No. 863027.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1. An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project consists of the construction of Class II bike lanes along North Jameson Lane from Olive Mill Road to Sheffield Drive. In addition, the bridges over Oak Creek, San Ysidro Creek, and Romero Creek will be replaced with wider bridges to accommodate the new bike lanes.

On August 28, 2001, the Board approved the Mitigated Negative Declaration (01-ND-27) pursuant to the County's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines as adequate environmental review for

the North Jameson Lane Class II Bike Lanes project. On January 15, 2002 the Board accepted an Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration (01-ND-27) and adopted the mitigation-monitoring program contained in the conditions of approval for the North Jameson Lane Class II Bike Lanes project. Further, the Board approved the project subject to the findings and conditions of approval included in the Conditional Use Permit (01CUP-00000-00089), dated December 4, 2001.



The project design is in the final design phase will be ready to advertise in October 2003. The “Notice to Contractors” will be published prior to the date set for the opening of the bids. Sealed proposals to construct this project will be received at the Public Works Conference Room, Santa Barbara County, Department of Public Works, County Engineering Building, 123 East Anapamu Street, Santa Barbara, California, and at the North County Public Works Office, 2400 Professional Parkway, Suite 150, Santa Maria California, at a date to be determined, and will be opened publicly and read aloud.

This project was approved as part of the FY 2000/2001 Capital Improvement Plan.

Subject: Authority to Advertise for North Jameson Lane Class II Bike Lanes Project 86027.

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Mandates and Service Levels:

Direction by the Board of Supervisors will not change the programs or service levels.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The Federal Highway Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement (HBRR) Program will fund 80% of the cost associated with the bridge replacements. The State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) will fund the construction of Class II bike lanes and Measure 'D' will provide for the 20% HBRR matching funds. STIP funding is approximately 33% of the project cost and HBRR funding is approximately 67% of the project cost.

Funds have been budgeted in Dept. 054, Fund 0015, Org Unit 0001, Program 2900, Account 7510
