WHEREAS, federal, state, and local parks preserve our history, cultural heritage, and the natural beauty of our county in perpetuity; and

WHEREAS, parks enhance the quality of life for all residents by providing outdoor recreation, educational opportunities for our local schools, family friendly amenities and places for reflection; and

WHEREAS, our local beaches, Guadalupe Dunes, the Los Padres National Forest and Lake Cachuma are just a few examples of the unique and well known parks in our county that serve over 3 million visitors annually; and

WHEREAS, parks preserve and protect our cherished open spaces by providing essential habitat for wildlife including many endangered or threatened species; and

WHEREAS, the County Parks system encompasses over 1,000 acres and Parks Department employees are dedicated to implementing environmentally friendly maintenance practices such as Integrated Pest Management Control;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors proclaims April 28 – May 4 as National Parks Week in Santa Barbara County and further encourages county residents to enjoy the many parks throughout our community.
