Approve and authorize the Chair to adopt a Resolution accepting portions of Foxen Lane and Coiner Street in the Third Supervisorial District, and Jensen Ranch Road, Solomon View Road, Canyon Creek Road, South Creek Court, Sycamore Creek Court, and Pine Creek Court in the Fourth Supervisorial District, into the County Road Maintained System.

Summary Text:

Road Name

The roads listed below were constructed to County Road Standards as part of residential developments. The easements that contain the roads were dedicated to the County during the map recordation process for each project. Public Works staff inspected each section of road during construction and deemed them all acceptable. The Department recommends that your Board accept the following roads into the County Road Maintained System:

Background:

The Public Works Department periodically requests that your Board accept roads into the public maintained system. Typically, the roads are constructed to public standards in conjunction with residential or commercial development. The roads are always within public easements, and are inspected during construction to ensure compliance with public road standards. Public Works inspects the roads again one year after completion to ensure quality, and if acceptable, they are eligible for acceptance into the public maintained road system.

The roads listed above within the Fourth Supervisorial District fall within the County of Santa Barbara Community Facilities District No. 2002-1. The District was created in 2002 to provide funding for police/sheriff protection services, fire protection services, maintenance of parks, parkways and open space, and flood and storm protection services with the Orcutt Planning Area. When the District was being formed, there was consideration that some of the funds generated from this District would be used to offset the cost of maintaining residential roads within the District. However, it was later determined that funds raised through the District could not legally be used to maintain roads. The County had made commitments to the developers through the tract map process to maintain the roads listed above, prior to determining that the CFD funds could not be used to maintain these roadways. The Public Works Department's current unfunded transportation backlog is over \$226 million; and therefore, in the future, we will not be recommending to your Board that residential roads within District No. 2002-1 be accepted into our County Road Maintained System. We will continue to recommend to your Board that arterial and collector roads within this District be accepted into our maintained road system.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Narrative:

Future maintenance costs for these roads will be funded through the Road Fund (Fund 0015). These roads will be added to the State mileage total for Santa Barbara County, and the gas tax revenue received from the State for road maintenance will be adjusted accordingly. The Department anticipates receiving approximately \$9,000 per year in additional gas tax revenue for these portions of road. To properly maintain these roadway segments, it will cost the Department approximately \$18,000/yr.


Board Resolution Vicinity Map


