That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Statement of Final Quantities for the Construction of the Norris and Twitchell Streets - Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Improvements Project; County Project No. 862371; Fourth Supervisorial District, for work performed and materials supplied by Civic Construction Associates (not a local vendor), 801 Walker Ave., Camarillo, CA, 93010, in the amount of \$159,415.38; and
- B. Determine that this project was found by your Board to be exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15301 on April 10, 2014, upon approval of the project, that a Notice of Exemption was filed on that basis, and that the completed action is within the scope of that Notice of Exemption.

Summary Text:

This Safe Routes to School Project replaced the previous uneven dirt shoulders with concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps along Norris and Twitchell Streets in Old Town Orcutt. Construction of this project placed 1,200 linear feet of new sidewalk improvements – approximately 600 feet on the east side of Norris Street and approximately 600 feet on west side of Twitchell Street.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as completed on January 26, 2015. The project was completed on budget and on time.

Background:

This project was requested by members of the Old Town Orcutt community and Orcutt Union School District. Public Works staff studied the area and found that pedestrian traffic to and from the school was steady both before and after school. In addition, navigating the uneven dirt path was often challenging and people frequently walked in the road. The department applied for and received funding for this project through a competitive federal program created to improve safety along routes to schools.

Narrative:

Total construction costs, including supplemental work and contingencies came to \$159,415.38. State Safe Routes to School (SR2SL) will fund \$143,473.84 (90%) of construction costs. Measure A – Alternative Transportation funds provided the remaining \$15,941.54 (10%). Funds for this project were budgeted in Dept. 054, Fund 0017, Org Unit 0600, Program 2830, and Account 7510.
