WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County has approximately 2,800 in-home supportive service workers providing care to about 3,400 recipients of the program, and;

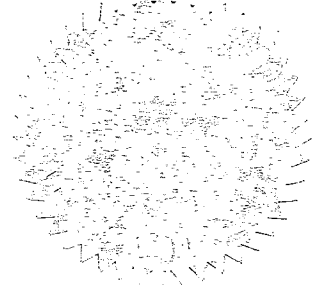
