

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Set date to consider and approve the amendment to the conflict of interest code of the Santa Barbara County Education Office ("education office.")

## ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with compliance with requirements of law regarding conflict of interest codes adopted by local agencies. The Political Reform Act of 1974, and its implementing regulations, requires local agencies to adopt, or amend, and to submit to the board of supervisors, acting as the codereviewing body, their respective conflict of interest codes, or amendments thereto. Such codes are effective upon approval by the board of supervisors.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION:**

On November 4, 2004, the education office adopted an amendment to its conflict of interest code, which amendment makes revisions to the designated positions set forth the code. The education office filed the amendment with the clerk of the board of supervisors for the board's approval.
