Agricultural Preserve Program

- Government Code §51200 et seq., aka the Williamson Act authorizes our agricultural preserve program.
- The goal of the agricultural preserve program is to retain land in an agricultural use.
- County Uniform Rules for Agricultural Preserves and Farmland Security Zones sets requirements contracted lands.
- Santa Barbara County has 1,300 agricultural preserve contracts of nearly 550,000 acres.

Agricultural Preserve Fees

- County Uniform Rules for Agricultural require Agricultural Preserve Contracts review
- November 7, 2006 Agricultural Preserve Fees removed
- General Funds allocated to agricultural planning funded Agricultural Preserve contract work.
- If approved future work will be revenue offset
