- 1. Accepts the renewal of Cooperative Agreement #990013 (Attachment A) between the State of California, Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) and the Santa Barbara County Fire Department for the loan of Federal Excess Personal Property;
- 2. Authorizes Fire Chief Mark Hartwig to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Board of Supervisors; and
- 3. Determines that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review as it is not a project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(2).






