Summary:

County Project No. 820607

On Thursday, June 29, 2006, three(3) bids were opened for the Construction of 2006/2007 County Wide Measure 'D' Preventive Maintenance Application of Scrub Seal and Micro Surfacing, County Project No. 820607. Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc., a California Corporation, submitted the lowest responsive bid in the amount of \$1,704,704.00, which was 42% above the Engineer's Estimate.

Staff has reviewed the bids and the available funding for the project and has determined that readvertising the project in February 2007 could result in more competitive bids and will allow the Department the opportunity to repackage the contract and get more creative on developing local sources of aggregate. During discussions with the construction community, the Department discovered that the contractor's were unable to secure a local source of aggregate which was one reason why the bids were higher than estimated. In addition to the lack of a local aggregate source, the sharp increase in oil prices over the last two months also resulted in higher bids. The Department is currently exporing the option of stockpiling aggregate from a local aggregate source in order to reduce costs to the project. Advertising in February 2007 will allow the County to stockpile enough aggregate for the project and repackage the project with the goal of obtaining more competitive bids. Approximately 29 lane miles of County maintained roadway were to be resurfaced as a result of this project.

The County also received a bid protest from one of the bidders on the project. The contractor claimed that language in the project special provisions regarding the submittal of test results for the emulsion were unclear. After consulting with County Counsel, it was determined that the language in the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions could have been worded more clearly and will be revised prior to readvertising the project in February 2007.

Due to the lowest responsive bid being 42% above the Engineer's Estimate as well as the unclear language in the project special provisions, staff recommends rejecting all bids for the project in accordance with Article 25, Section 20393 of the California Public Contract Code, and readvertising the project in February 2007, with construction commencing in May of 2007.
