Dear Chair Hart and Members of the Board:

The Santa Barbara County Agricultural Advisory Committee (the "AAC") has considered the above referenced matter at its November and December monthly meetings and has heard comments from Mr. Decker at both of those meetings. We appreciate the opportunity to comment briefly on the issue presented in this matter.

Although we have had extensive discussions about the policy implications of this project, we also recognize that we do not have the benefit of having heard all of the public comment and deliberation that has taken place related to the project. Nonetheless, while we recognize that there may be nuances of which we are unaware, we believe that it is important for the County to always be mindful of the Comprehensive Plan's Agricultural Element when considering matters such as this.

As you are aware, Policy I.B of the Comprehensive Plan Agricultural Element states that: "The County shall recognize the rights of operation, freedom of choice as to the methods of cultivation, choice of crops or types of livestock, rotation of crops and all other functions within the traditional scope of agricultural management decisions. These rights and freedoms shall be conducted in a manner which is consistent with: (1) sound agricultural practices that promote the long-term viability of agriculture and (2) applicable resource protection policies and regulations."
