## **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

For several years the County of Santa Barbara has been in violation regarding the size of particulate matter discharged into sewer system from the Jail campus on Calle Real. This has caused Goleta Sanitation considerable annual expense in repairs to their equipment and they have stated their intent to pass on these costs and fine the County. The fix is to install a "sewer grinder" to reduce any particulate to an acceptable size. Ten years ago a similar problem was remedied in this manner at Santa Barbara Juvenile Hall on Hollister Avenue.

Upon completion of this Project, the Santa Barbara Jail's sewage system will meet and satisfy Goleta Sanitation's requirements.
