- B. Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor in the amount of \$645,885.17.

Summary Text:

The project consisted of constructing a 64 feet long tieback retaining wall to repair a landslide that occurred during the storms of January 2005. The landslide was activated by winter rains and destroyed part of the road. The roadway was restored by constructing a tieback retaining wall. Construction included drilling and installing steel piles in concrete, placing wood lagging between the piles, installing tiebacks beneath the road, and restoration of the road.

This project was bid in accordance with Public Contract Code, which requires the award to the lowest responsible bidder. Work began on 8/21/06 and the Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on December 6, 2006. This project was completed on time and on budget.

During the initial series of storms of January 2005, intense rainfall runoff caused severe erosion and triggered a landslide resulting in partial loss of the roadway posing a hazard to the health and safety of the traveling public.

The contract for this project was awarded by your Board on 7/11/06.
