Recommended Actions: That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve the attached <u>Notice of Exemption</u> pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines (Post); and
- b) Execute the attached <u>Easement Deed</u> conveying an easement to the City of Santa Maria on a portion of the Santa Maria Government Campus (Cook and Miller Street) APN 125-064-007 for the purpose of minor alteration to an existing easement area for the installation of an above ground electrical transformer which will allow the reactivation of existing City water well.

Summary Text:

The City of Santa Maria is reactivating one of their existing water wells located on their adjoining property (Simas Park) to the County's Santa Maria Government Campus at Cook and Miller Street. The City has existing easements for utilities including other transformers on this County parcel and this easement will allow the placement of a new transformer. The easement area lies on the southern border of the parcel and will not affect the parcel's current usage as a parking lot. The granting of this easement to the City of Santa Maria will allow for the placement of this transformer

Grant of Easement to City of Santa Maria – Cook and Miller Street

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Background:

The County is the owner of property (APN 125-064-007) that is located on S. Miller in the City of Santa Maria and is part of the County Government Complex. The granting of this easement to the City of Santa Maria will convey an easement that limits the uses and activities that are permitted within the easement area. To accomplish this, the local power company requires that the well have its own power source or transformer. The Board's execution of the Easement Deed to City of Santa Maria will convey the property rights necessary for this minor alteration to an existing parking lot area to install an electrical transformer of the same type as are already located on the parcel. The Easement Deed will be recorded against the county property and filed in the Real Property Inventory for this county property.
