## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

For the

### Solar Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons located on Foster Road at Glenview Drive & Woodland Street

**Background:** Santa Maria Joint Union High School District requested a flashing beacon for the marked school crosswalk on Foster Road at Woodland Street. A study was done at this crossing and based on the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; justification for installing a flashing beacon was not met. However, the installation of a flashing beacon was allowed provided its purchase and installation are funded by the Santa Maria Joint Union High School District. Also, if the flashing beacon was going to be installed at Woodland Street, then a second flashing beacon would be required on Foster Road at Glenview Drive, which is a similar crossing located less than 300 feet to the east with the same funding provisions as the first one.

The decision was made to purchase two solar rectangular rapid flashing beacon systems that are push button activated. Each system will have flashing beacons at the marked crossing located on both sides of the street facing both directions with school symbol signs and downward arrow plates. Santa Maria Joint High School District donated funds to purchase and install the solar rectangular rapid flashing beacons. Santa Barbara County has agreed to permit the device in the public right of way and maintain the beacons.

#### This M.O.U. states the following agreements:

Both the County of Santa Barbara and Santa Maria Joint Union High School District agrees to the location of the poles and beacons on Foster Road at Woodland Street and Foster Road at Glenview Drive as shown on the construction plans.

Santa Maria Joint Union High School District will:

- Pay for \$20,000 of the purchase and installation of the beacons.

Santa Barbara County using 4<sup>th</sup> District funding will:

- Pay for any future costs associated with the repair or replacement of the beacons.

The Santa Barbara County Public Works Department will:

- Maintain the beacons by ensuring that it is in working condition and operates appropriately.
- Pay for \$12,000 of the purchase and installation of the beacons.
