**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS,
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA
AMENDING CHAPTER 23 OF THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CODE**

PROHIBITING THE USE OF BALLARD CANYON ROAD (FROM A POINT 1040 FEET SOUTH OF THE CENTERLINE OF FOXEN CANYON ROAD TO A POINT 2713 FEET SOUTH OF THE CENTERLINE OF FOXEN CANYON ROAD) BY TRUCKS OVER 30 FEET IN COMBINED LENGTH AND RESTRICTING PARKING OF “OVERSIZED VEHICLES” ON OLIVE MILL ROAD (SOUTH OF SPRING ROAD), CHANNEL DRIVE (EAST OF FAIRWAY ROAD), HILL ROAD, BUTTERFLY LANE (SOUTH OF HWY 101), CAMINO DEL REMEDIO, SAN ANTONIO ROAD (NORTH OF CALLE REAL), AND OAK GLEN DRIVE.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

The following sections of Chapter 23 of the Santa Barbara County Code is amended to read as provided herein:

Section 23-13.11. – Prohibiting the use of highways by certain vehicles.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, in accordance with section 21101(c) of the Vehicle Code of the State of California, may by ordinance adopt rules and regulations prohibiting the use of particular highways by certain vehicles, except as otherwise provided by the Public Utilities Commission pursuant to Article 2 (commencing with Section 1031 of Chapter 5 of Part 1 of Division 1 of the Public Utilities Code.

Rules and regulations prohibiting the use by certain vehicles are hereby established for the following highways:

BALLARD CANYON ROAD, from a point 1040 feet south of the centerline of Foxen Canyon Road to a point 2713 feet south of the centerline of Foxen Canyon Road:

Trucks over thirty feet in combined length are prohibited.

The designated alternate route for prohibited vehicles shall be Grand Avenue and Alamo Pintado Road.

HARRIS GRADE ROAD, from Burton Mesa Boulevard to State Route 135:

Autos with trailers over thirty feet in combined length, and trucks over thirty feet in combined length are prohibited.

The designated alternate route for prohibited vehicles shall be State Route 1.

Pursuant to Section 21103 of the California Vehicle Code, no provision of this section 23-13.11 shall be effective until signs giving notice of the local traffic laws are posted at all entrances to the highway or part thereof affected.

Pursuant to Section 21104 of the California Vehicle Code, a person who violates any provision of this section 23-13.11 shall be guilty of an infraction and subject to a fine of one hundred dollars.

Exemptions to any aforementioned prohibitions include emergency vehicles and any vehicles with the purpose of providing services, making pickups or deliveries of goods, wares and merchandise or delivering construction materials to sites within the restricted highway segment that have no other means of access utilizing the most direct route.

Section 23-13.12 – Prohibiting parking of “oversized vehicles” on certain streets between the hours of 10pm and 6am.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, in accordance with Section 22507(a) of the Vehicle Code of the State of California, may, by ordinance, adopt rules and regulations to prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles, on certain streets or highways, or portions thereof, during all or certain hours of the day.

(a) “Oversized vehicle(s)” shall be defined for this section as any motor vehicle, boat or trailer, which meets or exceeds at least one of the following criteria, exclusive of fixtures and accessories:

1. Twenty-four (24) feet in length; or
2. Seven (7) feet in height; or
3. Eight (8) feet in width.

(b) Rules and regulations prohibiting the parking of oversized vehicles between the hours of 10pm and 6am are hereby established for the following highways:

- OLIVE MILL ROAD, from Spring Road to Hill Road
- CHANNEL DRIVE, from Olive Mill Road to Fairway Road
- HILL ROAD, from Butterfly Lane to Olive Mill Road
- BUTTERFLY LANE, from Channel Drive to Union Pacific Railroad right of way
- CAMINO DEL REMEDIO, from Calle Real to Cathedral Oaks
- SAN ANTONIO ROAD, from Calle Real to Camino Del Remedio
- OAK GLEN DRIVE, from its southern intersection with Camino Del Remedio to its northern intersection with Camino Del Remedio

(c) Any violation of the herein stated provisions pertaining to the parking of oversized vehicles shall be subject to penalties of \$50 plus an administrative fee.

(d) The section shall not be enforceable until signs or markings giving adequate notice thereof have been placed.

SECTION 2: Parts Not Affected

Those sections of Chapter 23 not set forth in this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: Publication and Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from the date of its passage; and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it, or a summary of it, shall be published once, with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Santa Barbara as set forth in Government Code Section 25124.
