That the Board of Supervisors:

Consider recommendations regarding the Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) Agreement 08-85132 with the California Department of Health Care Services as follows:

- a. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute Agreement 08-85132 with the California Department of Health Care Services for Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) allowable for Federal Financial Participation (FFP), for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2011, in the amount of \$2,850,000.
- b. Authorize the Public Health Director to execute any future amendments for the Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) Agreement 08-85132 with the California Department of Health Care Services provided that any such amendments do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the annual allocation amount.

Summary Text:

This agreement is for a three-year period from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2011 and is the ninth renewal of an Agreement for MAA. Annual allocations are as follows:

The Agreement establishes the responsibilities and mutual objectives of Santa Barbara County and the California Department of Health Care Services relating to the provision of MAA for eligible Medi-Cal beneficiaries.

Authorizing this Agreement does not alter programs or service levels. MAA programs, for which FFP is claimed through this Agreement, operate under various mandates (Title 42, USC, Section 1396 et seq. and Welfare and Institutions (W&I) Code, Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 7, commencing with Section 14000) and service level requirements in the Public Health Department.

Background: This is the ninth renewal of an Agreement for MAA services which establishes the responsibilities and mutual objectives of Santa Barbara County and the California Department of Health Care Services. The mutual objectives are to assist eligible individuals in gaining access to needed medical, social, educational, and other services.

The administrative purpose of the Agreement is a technical requirement which permits the County to claim monies for services which, for the most part, we have been required to carry out in the course of other service requirements or mandates. They permit the County to access Federal money for services the State of California has chosen not to match through appropriated funds.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Budgeted: Yes

Fiscal Analysis:

Revenues for MAA were incorporated in the FY 2008-09 budget for Public Health for a total of \$790,740. Receipt of revenue from MAA is typically delayed at the State level due to the manner in which the MAA program is implemented. Therefore the budget is based on prior year's claims. No change in these projections is warranted at this time based upon execution of this Agreement.

This recommended action does not alter requirements for facilities in any way.
