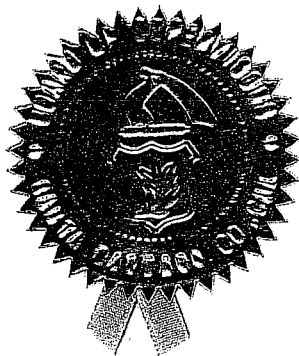

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED** that this Board of Supervisors proclaims September 21, 2011 as International Day of Peace in Santa Barbara County and encourages all residents of our community to participate in activities and events that are planned.
