







7-DAY ROLLING SUM OF NEW CASES BY AREA












DATA AS OF 10.20.20



Blueprint Framework

County risk level

	100K with 7-day lag, adjusted for number of tests performed	that are positive
WIDESPREAD Many non-essential indoor business operations are closed	More than 7 Daily new cases (per 100k)	More than 8% Positive tests
Some non-essential indoor business operations are closed	4-7 Daily new cases (per 100k)	5 – 8% and 5.3 – 8% health equity metric Positive tests
MODERATE Some indoor business operations are open with modifications	1 – 3.9 Daily new cases (per 100k)	2 – 4.9% and 2.2 – 5.2% health equity metric
MINIMAL Most indoor business operations are open with modifications	Less than 1 Daily new cases (per 100k)	Less than 2% and Less than 2.2% health equity metric





Santa Barbara County 7-day Average Adjusted* Case Rate per 100,000 Community Residents


