Approve Plans for the Unit II Channel Sediment Removal Project.

Summary Text:

The Unit II Channel is located northerly of West Main Street between Bonita School Road and Black Road in the incorporated area of Santa Maria. Over the years, sediment has accumulated within the Unit II Channel thus reducing its drainage conveyance capacity. In order to reestablish the capacity of this constructed facility, material will be removed along portions of the channel between West Main Street and the Santa Maria River Levee, a distance of approximately 2 miles. It is anticipated that a total of approximately 8,500 cubic yards of material will be removed, approximately half of which will be removed this fall and the remaining half next fall (2008). The work is broken into two phases in order to comply with environmental permitting requirements.

Background:

This project was included in Section 2 in the 2007-08 Annual Flood Control Maintenance Plan. Pursuant to Gov. Code 830.6 and Public Contracts Code 20124 these plans are hereby submitted for Board approval.
