RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MAY 11-18 AMERICORPS WEEK IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CALIFORNIA

WHERE AS, since 1994 nearly 500,000 AmeriCorps members have served in non-profit organizations, public agencies and faith-based organizations nation-wide; and

WHERE AS, each year 75,000 AmeriCorps members serve nation-wide to meet critical needs in education, the environment, public safety, disaster relief, and other areas; and

WHERE AS, nation-wide, AmeriCorps members recruit, train and manage millions of community volunteers; and

WHERE AS, over 65% of AmeriCorps alumni choose to pursue a career in the public or non-profit sector; and

WHERE AS, the Santa Barbara County Education Office coordinates a chapter of the AmeriCorps program that provides reading tutors to schools county-wide; and

WHERE AS, the Santa Barbara County Education Office chapter of AmeriCorps serves over 700 at-risk students annually by tutoring them in reading daily for the entire school year; and

WHERE AS, the Santa Barbara County Education Office chapter of AmeriCorps serves the schools of Santa Barbara County to increase disaster preparedness and recruit volunteers to support educational programs.

THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims the week of May 11th through 18th, 2008 "AmeriCorps" week in County of Santa Barbara.
