Staff recommends that the Board of Supervisors take the following actions:

- a) Make the required findings for approval of the Rezone ordinance (Case No. 23RZN-00001), included as Attachment A to this Board Letter;
- b) Adopt the Ordinance in Attachment B to approve a Rezone (Case No. 23RZN-00001) amending the Santa Barbara County Zoning Map of the County Land Use and Development Code to change Assessor's Parcel Numbers 107-150-021 and 107-150-022 from Highway Commercial (CH) to General Commercial (C-3); and
- c) Determine that pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15162, no substantial changes are proposed to the Famcon Pipe and Supply Rezone, no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the Famcon Pipe and Supply Rezone is undertaken, and no new circumstances or information of substantial importance has come to light regarding the environmental effects of the Famcon Pipe and Supply Rezone, and therefore the proposed action is within the scope of the Final Mitigated Declaration (Case No. 24NGD-00011) adopted by the Board of Supervisors, on August 26, 2025, and on file with the Clerk of the Board.

Summary Text:

On August 26, 2025, the Board of Supervisors made a motion to adopt a resolution to approve zoning amendments to the Land Use and Development Code Ordinance to revise the Santa Barbara County Zoning Map for Assessor's Parcel Numbers 107-150-021 and 107-150-022 from CH to C-3 zoning. Staff's recommended actions contained an error that was carried over to this motion. The prior Board Letter included the same ordinance included as Attachment B here; however, the recommended action for the Board should have stated adoption of an ordinance, rather than adoption of a resolution and the document's title should have included "ordinance" rather than "resolution". This board agenda letter was prepared to rectify the error and allow the Board to take action on the same ordinance included as Attachment B. The project is unchanged from what was considered and approved by the Board on August 26, 2025.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The need to resubmit this project to the Board stems from an administrative error. We confirm that no costs are being incurred by the Applicant.
