WHEREAS, the employer shared responsibility provision of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA), *26 U.S.C.A § 4980H*, mandates that employers offer health insurance coverage to employees and Contractors-on-Payroll, who do not currently receive health insurance benefits, and who meet the eligibility requirements of the ACA,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, as follows:

1. Effective January 1, 2015, County of Santa Barbara will offer medical benefits that provide affordable minimum essential coverage, as defined and required by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, *26 U.S.C.A § 4980H*; and
2. The County will apply the “rate-of-pay” safe harbor method for determining coverage affordability.
