WHEREAS, World AIDS Day is important to remind people that HIV has not gone away, and that there are many things still to be done to stop its spread in all populations; and

WHEREAS, World AIDS Day is a time for individuals and organizations from around the world to come together to bring attention to the global AIDS epidemic; and

WHEREAS, World Aids Day is also a time for communities to show solidarity and support for the many victims of AIDS and their loved ones who are affected throughout the globe;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors declares DECEMBER 1, 2008 as WORLD AIDS DAY and encourages all residents of Santa Barbara County to observe and participate in appropriate ceremonies and activities.
