RECOVERY AND WASTE MANAGEMENT DIVISION

RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS, according to Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code, the Board of Supervisors may revise the established Solid Waste Handling and Disposal Fees charged at County facilities upon the recommendation of the Public Works Department Director; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that the revised rate schedule will be just, fair, reasonable and sufficient to provide service to the public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, pursuant to state law and Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code, hereby, revises the solid waste handling and disposal fees charged at County Facilities, as presented in the attached schedules. Each of the rates established by the Resolution supersedes the rates established previously. Each of the rates established by this resolution will be effective July 1, 2025, and will continue to be in effect until revised, repealed, or otherwise amended.




