Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors receives and files the DNA identification fund report for calendar year 2018.

Summary Text:

California Government Code section 76104.6 directs California Courts to levy a \$1 penalty for every \$10 or fraction thereof upon every fine, penalty and forfeiture levied on criminal offenses including traffic offenses, but excluding parking offenses, to implement the DNA Fingerprint, Unsolved Crime and Innocence Protection Act (Proposition 69). The revenues from this penalty are deposited in the DNA Identification Fund established in the County's treasury. Monies in the fund are divided quarterly between the State and the County pursuant to Government Code 76104.6. The County must report to the State Legislature and the Department of Justice on the total amount of fines: (1) collected, (2) allocated and (3) expended for each authorized program.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The current balance in the Prop 69 DNA Identification fund is \$982,000.

Special Instructions:

Treasurer-Tax Collector will file the report with the Department of Justice and the State Legislature.
