RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MARCH 8, 2009 INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY **CALIFORNIA**

WHEREAS, women worldwide are assuming more visible and vocal roles throughout society by promoting peace, dignity, and unity while forming a collective voice that calls for new cooperative solutions to recurring conflicts; and

WHEREAS, International Women's Day has become a rallying point for coordinated efforts to encourage women to participate more fully in the political process; and

WHEREAS, women on all continents, divided by national boundaries and by ethnic, linguistic, cultural, economic and political differences, need to come together to celebrate this day, so they can reflect on a tradition that represents the on-going struggle for equality, justice, and peace; and

WHEREAS, the shared desire to uphold the dignity of all people has inspired action toward building and sustaining peace within our families, communities, and among nations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims March 8, 2009 as International Women's Day in Santa Barbara County and urges all residents to recognize the achievement of women in our society.
