- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$ 368,174.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Granite Construction Company (Not a Local Vendor), P. O. Box 50085, Watsonville, California 95077-5085, subject to the provisions of documents and certification, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project, as required under California Law:
- C. Authorize chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents, and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor Controller and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives;
- D. Approve contingency fund in the amount of \$ 30,908.70 for 2001/2002 General Fund Miscellaneous Concrete Repair and Asphalt Concrete Overlay in the 2nd, 3rd and 5th Supervisorial Districts and City of Goleta in Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 810480

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The project consists of concrete repair and surface treatment. The concrete repairs includes the removal and replacement of damaged concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks, installation of federal mandated curb ramps and tree root pruning and shielding. Approximately 685 linear feet of curb & gutter and sidewalk will be repaired. The surface treatment includes the rehabilitation and asphalt concrete overlay of the existing roadways. These repairs also include removing and repairing failed areas in the existing pavement. Approximately 5026 linear feet of County maintained roadway will be repaired and resurfaced with this project.

On Thursday, June 13, 2002, three (3) bids were opened for 2001/2002 General Fund Miscellaneous Concrete Repair and Asphalt Concrete Overlay in the 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} and 5^{th} Supervisorial Districts and City of

Goleta in Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 810480. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company, in the amount of \$ 368,174.00, which is 15.63% above the Engineer's Estimate. Public Works staff has reviewed the bid and have found it to be reasonable.

The project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the Department to award to the lowest responsible bidder.

The specific project locations were approved by the Board in the FY 2001/2002 Road Maintenance Annual Plan (RdMap).

This project was reviewed by the Capital Advisory Committee and Capital Improvement Committee and approved by your Board in the FY 2001/2002 Capital Improvement Plan.

Mandates and Service Levels:

No change in programs or service levels.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

This project was approved as a part of the 2001/2002 Road Maintenance Annual Plan. This project is funded with the General Fund contribution for road maintenance and is budgeted in Fund 0015, Org Unit 0001, Program 2900, Org. Unit 0002, Department 054 and Account 7510. The allotment is included in the construction cost centers of the Transportation Division on page D292 of the fiscal year 2002/2003 adopted budget.
