SUBJECT: County Appointment to LAFCO

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the Board of Supervisors on March 26, 2002 appoint or reappoint one member of the Board to fill an upcoming vacancy on LAFCO. The vacancy will be created on May 6, 2002 by the expiration of the current term of office of regular member Tom Urbanske. The new appointment should be for a term of office ending May 1, 2006.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

LAFCO is composed of two County Supervisors, two members of city councils, two directors from independent special districts and a member of the general public. There is an alternate member in each category to vote when a regular member in that category is absent or disqualified.

The County members are Tom Urbanske whose current term on LAFCO will expire on May 6 this year and Gail Marshall whose term expires May 2, 2005. The term of office of alternate member Susan Rose also expires in 2005.

Government Code §56334 specifies that terms of office on LAFCO are for four years, ending on the first Monday in May. Therefore the Board should appoint or reappoint one members to LAFCO through May 1, 2006.
