WHEREAS, Jeff Frapwell began his tenure with the County of Santa Barbara in February 2017 as Budget Director and Assistant County Executive Officer, after 30 years honing his skills in Kern County; and

WHEREAS, Jeff was instrumental in our most transformational efforts, such as a stand-alone IT department, Renew 22, InnovateSBC, and Workday; and

WHEREAS, fueled by his morning venti Starbucks and an unflappable Frapwell-focus, Jeff improved budgeting practices and inducted us all into the "School of Frapwell," making us more strategic, fiscally prudent and able to meet the Board's priorities; and

WHEREAS, in his tenure here, Jeff oversaw, mentored and guided many department directors, the budget and research team, the cannabis program, and risk management; led the issuance of \$98 million in Certificates of Participation, which generated a Triple A bond rating; and oversaw upgrades to the Board hearing rooms and modernization of the CEO office, saying he was allergic to 1970s wood paneling; and
