SUBJECT: **Proposed Establishment of a No Parking Zone on Northoaks Drive in the Vandenberg Village Area; Third Supervisorial District.**

RECOMMENDATIONS:

C.A. Recommendation: _____

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution for a no parking zone at the following location:

Northoaks Drive, along the south side from the centerline of Constellation Road to a point 179 feet east of the centerline of Northoaks Road.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION

A public meeting was held by the Third District Supervisor on July 24, 2002 at Cabrillo High School in Vandenberg Village. At this meeting, a concern was expressed regarding the safety of Northoaks Drive. From Constellation Road to a point approximately 150 feet east, Northoaks Road is only 20 feet wide. Currently on this portion of the roadway, parking is restricted on the north side and allowed on the south side. Vehicles parking on the south side make the road too narrow for two-way traffic and limit visibility for all vehicles. Public Works explained that if the road could not be widened then parking would need to be restricted and the first residence on Northoaks Drive would lose any on-street parking along its frontage. There was no opposition at the time of the meeting.

Further investigation showed that the county does not own enough right-of-way to widen this road. Therefore our recommendation is to restrict the parking on the south side of Northoaks Drive. The impact to the community will be minimal, and sufficient emergency access will be restored. Although one residence will have its on-street parking eliminated, there is plenty of parking available on the north side of the street just east of the narrow portion.

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Based on these results, the Public Works Department recommends the establishment of a no parking zone on the south side of the road at the above listed location.

MANDATES AND SERVICE LEVELS

No mandates or service levels are affected by this action.

FISCAL AND FACILITIES IMPACTS

Approximately \$50.00 will be required for red paint.
