SUBJECT: Order to Declare Surplus and Vacate; Sanja Cota Road (Portion)

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Adopt the attached resolution, <u>Order to Declare Excess and Vacate</u>, (4/5 vote required) vacating a portion of Sania Cota Road.
- B. Execute the attached <u>Quitclaim Deed</u> to Gainey Management LLC for the above referenced portion of Sanja Cota Road.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with <u>Goal No. 2</u>: A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit, and with actions required by law or by routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The County of Santa Barbara (hereinafter the "COUNTY") is the owner of that certain road right-of-way in the unincorporated area of the Santa Ynez Valley of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, commonly identified as a portion of Sanja Cota Road, (herein the "Road"). The Road was dedicated to the COUNTY for public use via a Grant Deed executed by the Patrick W. Riordan, Roman Catholic Archbishop of San Francisco on February 14, 1887, and recorded in Book 11, Page 552 of Deeds in the Office of the County Recorder of the County of Santa Barbara. The portion of the Road located within Assessor's Parcel

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Executive Summary and Discussion (Cont.):

Numbers 141-450-003, -004 and 141-440-011 was never developed or used by the public and is shown on "Attachment A" which is attached to the above referenced resolution (herein the "Portion"). The Portion is not included in the County maintained roadway system and does not have any other County use.

On September 9, 2003, your Board approved and accepted a Donation Agreement between Gainey Management, LLC, the Santa Ynez Band of Mission Indians and the County of Santa Barbara. As part of that agreement the County agreed to relinquish all right, title and interest in the Portion of Sanja Cota Road located on parcels 141-450-003, -004 and 141-440-011, which parcels are owned by Gainey. The Portion is the subject of the attached Order to Declare Excess and Vacate.

The Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting of October 28, 2003 adopted Resolution Number 03-??? regarding its intention to declare as excess and vacate the Portion, and authorized publication of such pending action. Notice was published in the Santa Ynez Valley News, and posted on the Portion as required by law. Also on October 28th, your Board approved an addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration previously approved on September 9, 2003; as 03-ND-12 and acknowledged that the addendum was completed in compliance with CEQA guidelines and together with the Mitigated Negative Declaration is adequate for the Sanja Cota Project, including necessary property transactions.

If adopted by your Board and recorded the <u>Order to Declare Surplus and Vacate</u> will remove the COUNTY'S right-of-way interest from the Portion. The <u>Quitclaim Deed</u> will remove whatever ownership interest the COUNTY may have in the Portion.
