- B. Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for this project by the Contractor in the amount of \$229,007.89.

#### **Summary Text:**

This project was accepted as complete by County Parks on December 10, 2010. This project involves the repair of existing failed areas, grinding of existing pavements, replacement of damage curbs and speed humps, construction of concrete drainage swales, placement of asphalt concrete overlay, and restriping of the parking lots.

**Background:** Maintenance of existing pavement at Don Potter area has been deferred over the last 10-15 years due to lack of available funds. High use of the recreation area, tree roots damaged and inadequate water run off have contributed to deterioration of the roadways and parking lots. While potholes have been patched regularly, this has lead to an uneven road surface.

There are no impacts to facilities with this action. Construction of this project will improve site condition and protection to facilities and equipment from weather damage.
