Recommended Actions:

- 1. Approve and execute an amendment to the contract with Aurora Vista del Mar Hospital (not a local vendor) to continue providing acute hospital services to seriously mentally ill adults for the period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 in the amount of \$280,200, for a total contract in the amount of \$900,000.
- 2. Authorize the Director of ADMHS to approve amendments to the proposed contract, provided that any such amendments do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the contract's dollar amount.

Summary Text:

Aurora Vista Del Mar (Aurora) provides acute Psychiatric Inpatient Hospital Services to adults with severe mental illness (SMI). Aurora provides observation and treatment for clients admitted involuntarily because they are determined to be a danger to themselves or others, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code 5150. Aurora has provided a higher number of hospital services to Santa Barbara County residents in FY 06-07, thereby requiring a contract amendment to continue services through the remainder of the year.

Background:

Aurora is the primary acute inpatient hospital providing services to county clients in need of hospitalization when the Santa Barbara County Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF) is at capacity. Aurora, located in Ventura, is one of the closest facilities accepting client referrals from Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Services (ADMHS). Aurora provides Psychiatric Inpatient Hospital Services such as

psychiatric assessment, medication management and therapeutic services to clients requiring one-to-one intensive supervision. The services are designed to stabilize patients as rapidly as possible and return them to an improved level of functioning.

ADMHS has experienced an unanticipated increase of involuntary hospitalizations at Aurora since Cottage Hospital relinquished its "5150" designation and does not accept involuntary psychiatric clients. Clients may be referred to the San Luis Obispo County PHF as space allows, however, scarce other local resources and a PHF that is regularly at capacity, has resulted in considerable growth in the number of individuals with acute SMI being placed with Aurora. Based on this trend, the provider will exceed the services anticipated by the original contract for FY 06-07 which the recommended contract amendment will accommodate.

Performance Measure:

In the first six months of FY 06-07, Aurora admitted approximately 100 ADMHS and provided 883 hospital bed days with an average length of stay of 8.8 days.

Approval of the recommended action will assist ADMHS in meeting the following **Recurring Performance Measures:**

RPM 0230 to provide effective mental health care to 4,900 seriously mentally ill adults.

Mental Health Services are mandated by the Welfare and Institutions Code, Section 5600.

The Aurora Vista Del Mar contract is funded by Realignment revenue. This funding source is identified in the Adopted FY 2006-07 Budget, Federal and State Revenues line item 4102 – Realignment, (page D-144 in the County Budget Book, in the Hospital and Jail Services Division). The proposed expenditures are included in the FY 2006-07 budget for Professional and Special Services, Expenditure Line Item Account 7460. Execution of this amendment will not increase the use of general fund dollars by the ADMHS Department.
