NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the following location situated in the County of Santa Barbara and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County is hereby designated as a (2-Way) Stop Intersection and that the Director of Public Works of the County of Santa Barbara is hereby authorized and directed to install and maintain appropriate pavement markings and signs at the hereinafter-described locations:

On Manzana Street at its intersection with Faraday Street.
