- (B) Adopt a resolution that orders the increase in membership to five members of the Board of Trustees of the Santa Maria Public Cemetery District.
- (C) Appoint two persons to the Board of Trustees of the Santa Maria Public Cemetery District for a four year term, until the appointment and qualification of the successor.

**Summary Text:** On April 15, 2008, the Board of Supervisors considered a request from the Santa Maria Cemetery District to increase the membership of its Board of Trustees from three to five members. The Board of Supervisors directed staff to continue the process to allow an increase in membership, including soliciting applications for two additional Board of Trustees' members.

**Background:** This item is on the Board of Supervisors' agenda to adopt a resolution to increase the membership of the Santa Maria Cemetery District's Board of Trustees to five members, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code § 9025, and to appoint two additional member of the public to serve on the District's Board of Trustees. Each newly appointed member will serve a four year term (May 13, 2008-May 13, 2012) until the appointment and qualification of the successor.
