#### **Summary Text:**

The Santa Barbara County Hydrology Report for 2010-11, dated October 2011, includes documentation and analysis of multi-year rainfall, stream-flow, and reservoirs within the County.

The report also includes watershed burn-area hydrologic assessment & photographs associated with the 5 major wildfires that were experienced within the past 4 years (Zaca, Gap, Tea, Jesusita, and La Brea).

The intention of this report is to concisely document hydrologic observations and processes of recent years, and to provide a reference document for future years.

The Public Works Department will place this report on our website to download free of charge. This report will also be available in a printed color version at the County's various Libraries.

#### **Background:**

The Hydrology section within the Water Resources Division of Public Works periodically prepares water-year reports covering hydrologic processes & observations, particularly following more significant rainfall years. These reports were first published in 1991.

The report documents the significant Hydrology (surface water) related events for the 2010-2011 wateryear in Santa Barbara County.

This 106 page report includes a 1-page executive summary, which is followed by more detailed discussion of Hydrologic Monitoring Systems, Weather Forecast, Burn-Areas, Storm Summary, Rainfall, Rivers & Streams, Reservoirs, Flood-Flow Modeling, and other related topics.

Report Appendices are inclusive of reference information on Hydrologic Gauge Station listings, Hydrologic Station Installation pictures, Yearly/Monthly Rainfall listings, and Rainfall Return Periods.

The rainfall year and water year (WY2011) referred to in this report runs from September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011.
