WHEREAS, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender individuals make important, positive contributions to the arts, sciences an technology, business, media, health care, education, social services, and government in Santa Barbara County; and

WHEREAS, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender Pride Festivals and events present an important opportunity to recognize the vitality and visibility of California's Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender communities to ensure the respect of, and dignity for, every Californian; and

WHEREAS, the 2007 Pacific Pride Festival shall celebrate the diversity and the sense of community among Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and allied individuals, promoting acceptance, understanding and equality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaim July 14, 2007 as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender Pacific Pride Festival Day in Santa Barbara County.
