Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with City of Goleta for the San Jose Creek Multipurpose Path from the Obern Trail to City Limits;
- b) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a Freeway Maintenance Agreement Sandspit UC, Goleta ATP Bike Path 05-1K630 with Caltrans;
- c) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a Resolution of Change with Caltrans revising the State Route 217 (SR217) Freeway Maintenance Agreement to reflect the construction of a Class I Bike Path along SR 217 and for the undercrossing of SR 217; and
- d) Find that the recommended actions do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15378 (b)(5) (Organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment).

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Goleta (City), to authorize a Freeway Maintenance Agreement (FMA) with Caltrans, and to execute a Resolution of Change for the San Jose Creek Multipurpose Path. In January 2019, the City received a State Active

MOU, FMA, and Resolution of Change Pertaining to the San Jose Creek Multipurpose Path from the Obern Trail to City Limits; Second Supervisorial District
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Transportation Plan (ATP) grant to design and construct the San Jose Creek Multipurpose Path from Calle Real to the Obern Trail. The City of Goleta is the implementing agency for this project however a portion of the project is within County jurisdiction therefore it is necessary to establish maintenance agreements with the City and Caltrans.

Background:

The San Jose Creek Bike Path is one of the City's ATP projects which will construct a multipurpose path adjacent to San Jose Creek connecting areas north of U.S. Route 101 with the Class I Atascadero Creek Bikeway (Obern Trail) east of State Route 217. The purpose of the Project is to close the multipurpose path gap in the regional active transportation network. The Project will provide a direct and continuous route for bicyclists and pedestrians from north of Calle Real to commercial and residential areas within Goleta Old Town and to the existing Class I Atascadero Creek Bikeway providing access to Goleta Beach Park, the University of California Santa Barbara (UCSB) and to the City of Santa Barbara.




Figure 1: County Maintenance Responsibility Area

The southernmost 1500 linear feet of the project falls within the County of Santa Barbara's jurisdiction. Under this MOU with the City of Goleta, the County shall be responsible for maintaining all elements covered by the Freeway Maintenance Agreement (FMA) between Caltrans and the County in the County's jurisdictional area south of the undercrossing shown in Figure 1. The City directed the City Manager to enter into this MOU with the County at their September 19, 2023 Council meeting.

Also, before your Board is a resolution requesting Caltrans revise the SR 217 FMA to reflect the construction of the bike path along SR 217 and between the San Jose Creek bridge and the western Goleta city limit. The County's maintenance responsibilities include: bike path drainage, bike path surface, exterior curb, pedestrian railing, nonstructural elements of the SR 217 pedestrian undercrossing including graffiti removal, as well as the removal and cleanup of encampments from persons experiencing homelessness.
