(BC-18-175) FIRST AMENDMENT

Effective June 5, 2018

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (hereinafter referred to as First Amendment) is made by and between the County of Santa Barbara, a political subdivision of the State of California having its principle place of business at 105 East Anapamu Street, Room 304, Santa Barbara, California, 93101 (hereafter COUNTY) and Rotorcraft Support Inc. with an address of 16425 Hart St., Van Nuys, CA 91406 (hereafter CONTRACTOR), is effective as of June 5, 2018 ("First Amendment Effective Date").

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2018 the parties entered into Agreement BC-18-175 for helicopter repair and maintenance services for helicopter 308 (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to add funding; and

WHEREAS, this First Amendment incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, approved by the County of Santa Barbara.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. The Compensation of the Contractor is increased by \$190,000, from \$150,000 to \$340,000, and the 10% contract contingency is increased by \$19,000, from \$15,000 to \$34,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$374,000, as follows:
 - Section 5 <u>COMPENSATION OF CONTRACTOR</u>. For CONTRACTOR services to be rendered under this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be paid a total contract amount, including cost reimbursements, not to exceed \$340,000.00.
 - A. Additional efforts and cost reimbursements within the scope of **EXHIBIT A** that exceed \$340,000.00 may be authorized by the Fire Chief or designee at the same rate per unit as defined in **EXHIBIT A**. Additional efforts and cost reimbursement must be approved in advance by the Fire Chief or designee. The total amount of this contingency fund is not to exceed 10% of the Agreement amount or \$34,000.00 In no event shall the COUNTY be liable for the cost of any changes or additions to the services being performed under this Agreement unless approved in advance and in writing by the Fire Chief or designee. In no event shall the total contract amount exceed \$374,000.00.

- 2. **Exhibit A STATEMENT OF WORK** shall be replaced in its entirety by the Amended Exhibit A STATEMENT OF WORK, which is attached and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. **Exhibit B PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS** shall be replaced in its entirety by the Amended Exhibit B PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS, which is attached and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. <u>Counterparts.</u> The First Amendment may be executed in several counterparts, all of which taken together shall constitute a single agreement between the parties.
- 5. <u>Ratifications.</u> The terms and provisions set forth in this First Amendment shall modify and supersede all inconsistent terms and provisions set forth in the Agreement. The terms and provisions of the Agreement, as expressly modified and superseded by this First Amendment, are ratified and confirmed and shall constitute in full force and effect, and shall continue to be legal, valid, binding and enforceable obligations of the parties.

Additional efforts and costs reimbursement must be approved in advance by the Fire Chief or designee. The total amount of this contingency fund is not to exceed 10% of the Agreement amount or \$34,000.00 In no event shall the COUNTY be liable for the cost of any changes or additions to the services being performed under this Agreement unless approved in advance and in writing by the Fire Chief or designee. In no event shall the total contract amount exceed \$374,000.00.
- C. Payment for services and /or reimbursement of costs shall be made upon CONTRACTOR's satisfactory performance, based upon the scope and methodology contained in **EXHIBIT A** as determined by COUNTY.
- D. CONTRACTOR may invoice separately for the parts required to complete the work in EXHIBIT A, prior to performing the maintenance and repairs on the equipment, once the parts are ordered and actual costs are identified. CONTRACTOR shall submit to the COUNTY DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE an invoice or certified claim on the County Treasury for the parts ordered. This invoice or claim must cite the assigned Board Contract Number. COUNTY DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE shall evaluate the item(s) ordered and if found to be satisfactory shall initiate payment processing. COUNTY shall pay invoices or claims for satisfactory work within 30 days of receipt of correct and complete invoices or claims from CONTRACTOR.
- E. Upon completion of the work detailed in **EXHIBIT A** and/or delivery to COUNTY of item(s) specified therein, CONTRACTOR shall submit to the COUNTY DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE an invoice or certified claim on the County Treasury for the service performed. This invoice or claim must cite the assigned Board Contract Number. COUNTY DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE shall evaluate the quality of the service performed and/or the item(s) delivered and if found to be satisfactory shall initiate payment processing. COUNTY shall pay invoices or claims for satisfactory work within 30 days of receipt of correct and complete invoices or claims from CONTRACTOR.
- F. COUNTY's failure to discover or object to any unsatisfactory work or billings prior to payment will not constitute a waiver of COUNTY's right to require CONTRACTOR to correct such work or billings or seek any other legal remedy.
