Summary Text:

This item is before your Board to approve Santa Barbara Sheriff’s Office (SBSO) additional on-going grants to the FY 2025-26 fiscal year that were inadvertently overlooked from the Grant Management System (GMS) during the initial setup process. These grants were previously included in the FY 2024-25 cycle; however they were inadvertently omitted during the FY 2025-26 process. They have since been included in the FY 2026-27 on-going grant list, but Board approval is needed to formally add them to the FY 2025-26 fiscal year. There is

Discussion:

Approval is requested to add the attached grants to the FY 2025-26 on-going grant list. These grants were inadvertently overlooked from the FY 2025-26 on-going grant list in the GMS system setup process and therefore were not included in the original Board approved list for the fiscal year. Board approval is requested at this time to formally add the grants to the on-going grant list for FY 2025-26. The grants have since been included in the FY 2026-27 grant list to ensure they are captured moving forward. Please see the grant list below totaling \$5.6 million for all fifteen grants.

Background:

On-going grants are defined as grants that have previously received Board approval and are anticipated to continue through renewal cycles or as part of multi-year funding agreements. These grants are considered on-going due to their recurring nature and continued operational relevance to the department.

The on-going grants process was established to improve administrative efficiency and streamline the Board approval process. Given the significant number of grants received and managed countywide, bringing each recurring grant individually through the approval process annually became increasingly time-consuming and administratively burdensome. To address this, the on-going grants list was implemented to consolidate recurring and previously approved grants into a standardized annual process.

Typically, the on-going grants list is included as part of the Board Letter accompanying the June budget hearings. This process ensures the Board is informed of grants anticipated to continue into

the upcoming fiscal year and allows departments to efficiently maintain grant operations without interruption. During the FY 2025-26 process, the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Office inadvertently overlooked submitting several on-going grants from the attachment presented to the Board. This Board letter remedies that omission by formally bringing forward all applicable on-going grants for Board consideration as reflected in Attachment A.

The on-going grants were previously included and approved as part of the FY 2024-25 fiscal year process. During preparation of the FY 2025-26 on-going grant listings, the grants were unintentionally left out of the GMS and were not brought forward for Board approval. Staff identified this oversight during the FY 2026-27 preparation process and have included the on-going grants in the upcoming fiscal year list to prevent future gaps.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Fiscal impacts are limited to the grant amounts previously budgeted within the department's existing FY 2025-26 appropriations. No additional General Fund contribution is requested. There are no facilities impacts associated with this action.
