

ED CRAWFORD DAY

COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING JUNE 30, 2002 CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Edward "Ed" J. Crawford was born in Keewatin Minnesota. He spent four years in the Air Force and moved to Santa Maria in 1969; and

WHEREAS, Ed has been married to his wife Betty, for 40 years. They have three children and five grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Ed was staff representative for State Senator Omar Raines from 1979 to 1982 and during this period he worked with Social Security issues and substance abuse legislation; and

WHEREAS, from 1983 until 1985, Ed worked with Santa Maria SPAN and Central Coast Headway, which are drinking/driving and substance abuse programs; and

WHEREAS, in 1985 Ed found out that there were no substance abuse programs in the Santa Maria High School District and voluntarily set up the program that is currently being used today in all three high schools. Edward volunteered his time at all three high schools with this program until it was sanctioned in 1987 by the school board. In 1987 two other substance abuse consultants were hired and Edward chose to stay with Delta High School where he is currently employed; and

WHEREAS, finding there was limited access after 5:00 p.m. in a time of crisis for someone to talk to, Edward made his phone number available to present and past students and other members of the community; and

WHEREAS, Edward has dedicated his life to helping children and parents in the community, not only by making himself available, but also by collecting clothes and food for the needy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND HEREBY ORDERED, that the Board of Supervisors, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, proclaim June 30, 2002 as ED CRAWFORD DAY. Passed and adopted by a unanimous vote of all members present this 14th day of May 2002.
