- a) Accept a \$27,500 grant from the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) to assist the Sheriff's Project Safe Neighborhood-Anti Gang Initiative program.
- b) Approve Budget Revision 2007704 recognizing the grant revenue and appropriating expenditures within the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Department.

Summary Text:

On January 27, 2009, The Santa Barbara Sheriff's Department was awarded a grant of up to \$27,500 from California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) for participation in the Project Safe Neighborhood-Anti Gang Initiative program. This program enhances law enforcement resources in the detection and investigation of gang related crimes. The Santa Barbara Sheriff's Department will receive up to \$27,500 for participation in this program and will use these funds for overtime, training, and equipment.

Background: Statistics show that there are 14 identified street gangs within the 1,990 gang members documented throughout the County. In addition, there are also several outlaw motorcycle gangs found in the County. Gang-related incidents have become commonplace. The Sheriff's Department is the largest law enforcement agency in the County and has contact with all 14 criminal street gangs and outlaw motorcycle gangs. The Sheriff's Department Gang Unit is often called when other agencies need



assistance with gang related crimes. The Sheriff's Department Gang Unit also routinely assists other agencies with street fairs, festivals, car shows, motorcycle runs, funerals, and probations/parole sweeps. This grant will allow deputies to work these events and assist allied agencies utilizing grant overtime instead of taking time away from the Gang Unit's primary responsibility, which is targeting the gangs that live in Sheriff's Departments direct jurisdiction. The grant will also pay for specialized training and equipment, which should improve productivity and efficiency.
