BACKGROUND



- Existing Ordinance Adopted by Board of Supervisors in 1998
 - Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 12, titled Civil Defense and Disaster
 - The Office of Emergency Services in SB Co Fire Department
 - Provided for succession of Board members
 - Defined the Disaster Council members, and emergency organization



REASON for AMENDMENT



- Establishes the current authorities and systems for the protection of people, property, and the environment in case of emergencies or disasters
- Places Office of Emergency Management in the County Executive's Office
- Complies with State and Federal laws relating to current emergency management practices



REASON for AMENDMENT



- Defines emergencies and the emergency proclamation process
- Defines the emergency organization
- Establishes Recovery Advisory Council



RECOMMENDED ACTIONS



- Consider introduction of ordinance amending Chapter 12 of the Santa Barbara County Code (Attachment A)
- Set hearing for November 4, 2014 to consider adoption of the ordinance amendment (Administrative Agenda)
